Second Saturdays at Cliveden Return

Volunteer opportunity & free events every second Saturday, June through October in 2023

Free tours of Cliveden's new exhibit, *The Turmoil of Transition*, part of Second Saturdays event

Second Saturday programs return to Cliveden every second Saturday, June through October. Second Saturdays are free to the public as part of Cliveden's community engagement work with Historic Germantown and Stenton and is supported by The Pew Center for Arts & Heritage. Each month, neighbors can assist with the landscape and gardens at Cliveden as well as attend free programs, take free tours of the Main House, engage with local vendors and more.

Second Saturdays begin with volunteer work on the landscape and gardens from 9am to 12pm. The five-and-a-half-acre property is home to a variety of trees and four gardens, including a pollinator garden. Volunteers will work with Libbie Hawes, Preservation Director, and Jamie Davenport, Gardener, on a variety of projects such as pruning trees, mulch distribution, and weeding. No registration or prior experience is necessary.

From 12pm to 4pm, Cliveden will host a free event based on the theme of the day. The Second Saturday themes are Families & Children (June 10th); Citizenship (July 8th and August 12th); Back to School (September 9th), and Advocacy (October 14th). The event will include free tours of Cliveden's new exhibit, *The Turmoil of Transition: The mid-nineteenth century at Cliveden*, free refreshments, and local vendors. The grounds will remain open to the public during these hours and landscaping volunteers are welcome to stay for the day's event.
